MAKING MAGIC: JOURNEY OF A BOOK

Grades K-5 (45-50 minute assembly)

In this presentation, I'll walk students through the various stages of the writing and publishing process using a True/False game and digital slideshow. We'll talk about idea notebooks, messy first drafts, writing partners, editorial feedback, book designers, sketch dummies, and more! I'll share about my life as a writer, and how creativity, collaboration, patience, and perseverance all play a major role in this work...and in many kinds of work! With a read aloud and/or Q + A at the end, this offering can be tailored to various age/size groupings.

IDEA CATCHERS: OBSERVE, EXPLORE, WONDER, REPEAT

Grades K-1 (30-40 minute workshop) or Grades 2-3 (40-50 minute workshop)

In this workshop (which could be single classroom or whole grade-level), we will focus on "catching ideas" - the very first step of the writing process. I'll share examples of how many of my books and poems began in my own backyard, simply by paying attention to what was right in front of me. We'll look at different methods for collecting sights and sounds and magic moments, and then take some time to begin that work together. Students will end this workshop empowered and excited to explore their own corner of the universe!

CRAFTING POETRY: READ, WRITE, PLAY

Grades K-1 (45-60 minute workshop)

Poetry is all about play! In this classroombased workshop, we will read an assortment of poems, noticing things about each one, and explore the special things poets (and all writers) do as they work. Then we will "play with words" in a fun activity as we craft some poems together!

MAKING POEMS SHINE: READ, WRITE, PLAY, POLISH

Grades 2-3 (60 minute workshop)

Writers read, they write, they play...and they polish that writing until it shines. From first draft to polished poem, students will get a behind-the-scenes look at the writing process in this classroom-based workshop, with a particular focus on revision. After exploring some of the special things poets do to make their words shine, we'll dive into some poetry of our own with two engaging and accessible poem-building activities.

EDUCATOR WORKSHOPS

Besides working with students, I also love spending time with educators! Below are professional development workshops that can be added onto a school visit for a reduced rate, or done as stand-alone sessions. Handouts/resources included.

POETRY IN THE PRIMARY CLASSROOM:

This one-hour workshop is all about the power and possibility of poetry in the classroom. Poetry will be examined as a teaching tool across the day - one that can be embedded into all parts of the curriculum with loads of benefits. Come play and learn!

THE SECRET MAGIC OF PICTURE BOOKS:

This one-hour workshop takes a deep dive into the many layers of an important and often misunderstood genre. We will explore and celebrate the breadth and depth of picture books - focusing on the many profound ways they can impact classrooms from K-12.

VIRTUAL VISITS

If in-person doesn't work for you, both "Making Magic" & "Idea Catchers" can be offered virtually. These could be done as a single classroom or a grade level gathered together. The smaller the group, the more interactive it can be. Twenty-minute virtual read aloud sessions are also available with no fee, when schools purchase a minimum of ten books (bookstore of your choice).
